4. Conditions of Permit

The Service may approve brown trout for stocking of ponds and dams for public fishing, subject to the following conditions:

Preferred minimum surface area of dam 2.5 Ha or 25,000 m²

Landowner to enter into a Farm Dam Access Licence Agreement with the Service. A proforma copy of the Licence Agreement is available on the IFS website.

Provision of reasonable public access to the water that is stocked with brown trout by the Service equivalent to one of the following:

- 1. Unlocked gates providing direct vehicle access to the dam or to parking within easy walking distance of the dam (Less than 500m)
- 2. Foot access from a public road. A safe parking area must be available within easy walking distance of the dam (Less than 500m)
- 3. Access by prior permission. Either foot or vehicle access as described in 1. or 2. (Above). Signage displayed at the access point with landowners contact details including mobile phone number/s. All reasonable requests for access must be granted.

Landowner to maintain public liability insurance.

The Service to conduct a safety assessment and inspection of the dam and access.

Property owner retains the right to restrict or suspend access due to farming operations.

Anglers Access signage and infrastructure supplied, installed and maintained by the Service.

Dam location details will be made available to the public.

If your application is approved, the IFS will deliver fish to the nominated dam subject to availability.

The trout may not be artificially fed.

The trout may only be taken from the stocked water by means of angling under the current regulations and all anglers over 14 years of age must be licensed, including the landowner. A summary of the regulations is contained within the Tasmanian Inland Fishing Code.

Fishing is only permitted during the open season, ie between the first Saturday in August and the Sunday nearest 30 April.

Your permit allows you to only stock the single water nominated on this application.
